## Assessment Taking Strategies

### Introduction

Technique	Remarks
<i>Concentrate</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Make sure you situate yourself in a room that is quiet and distraction free.</li> <li>- Try to block out all distractions and focus only on the test.</li> <li>- If lighting in the room is poor, sit under a light fixture.</li> </ul>
<i>Read critically</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Read all directions and questions carefully.</li> </ul>
<i>Get plenty of rest</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Make sure you are well rested and alert before you complete the test.</li> </ul>
<i>Prepare for the assessment if taken remotely</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Be clear of the test due date. Allot plenty of time to complete the test by the due date.</li> <li>- Ensure the device you will be completing the test is working properly. Make sure that you have the latest version of Internet Explorer, Chrome or Firefox browser.</li> <li>- Take the test in an area with good internet connection.</li> </ul>
