Summary: SCE submits this report as it may involve an event that meets the subject of significant public attention or media coverage reporting requirement. Preliminary information indicates the Cambria Fire ignited at approximately 9:20 a.m. and forward progress was stopped by 10:00 a.m. The fire burned approximately 5 acres of brush and there were no reports of any structures damaged. We have no record of any primary circuit activity, but the fire reportedly ignited near a pole that supports secondary facilities. The investigation is ongoing.
